How it works

DESIGN AND ORDER PROCESS

Creating print data for your Print Tattoos is quick and easy.

Please follow the steps below:

1. Download the layout template

Go to: <https://www.print-tattoo.com/en/print-data-with-layout-templates/> Select your desired format and download the file.



2. Open the template

Open the template in a graphic design program of your choice (we recommend Adobe Illustrator).

3. Design your artwork & save

Edit the template. Please note the following:

- **Multiple designs on one sheet:** Keep a minimum distance of 5 mm between individual designs. A margin of 5 mm must be maintained on all sides from the edge.
 - **Maximum file size:** 10 MB
 - **Image resolution:** 300–450 dpi
 - Are you creating tattoos with white ink, metallic colors, or glitter? Please follow the instructions on the second page of the template.
 - Please create your artwork without transparencies or transparent effects.
 - No clipping paths or cut-out paths.
 - The back print is produced in grayscale. For a full-color back print, please contact us via email.
 - All graphics and fonts must be embedded or converted to outlines to ensure optimal print quality.
- 4. Save your file**
Save your file as PDF, JPEG, or TIFF. For designs with bleed or edge-to-edge elements, please include 3 mm bleed. Please save your file as standard PDF/X-4, JPEG, or TIFF using the color profile ISO Coated v2 (300%)
- 5. Submit print data**
Send your print files to us by email.

NOTE ON PRINT PREVIEW

Please send us your artwork exactly as it should appear on the skin. For production reasons, your design will be printed mirrored, so that it appears correctly when applied to the skin. If you have already mirrored your artwork, please let us know.

NOTE ON WHITE ELEMENTS

Does your design include white elements? In the Layers panel, you will find a layer named "White Ink". Make this layer visible and place all areas that should be printed in white on this layer. Color all elements on this layer using the swatch "White". This is a spot color defined as 100% Magenta, which will be printed as white during production. This ensures that white areas remain visible and that colors appear vibrant. Only the design itself is backed with white ink — the background remains transparent. Make sure that "Overprint Fill" is enabled under "Window > Attributes".

NOTE ON METALLIC TATTOOS (GOLD, SILVER, BRONZE)

For metallic tattoos, only graphics or text elements are possible — photos cannot be used. Your design will be printed entirely in the selected metallic color (Gold, Silver, or Bronze). Please ensure that lines are at least 0.5 mm thick.

You can use either Gold, Silver, or Bronze per sheet — or a combination of Gold and Silver. Bronze cannot be combined with Gold or Silver.

Gold. Place all areas that should appear in gold on the layer "Metallic Shade 1" and color all elements on this layer using the swatch "Gold" (spot color with 100% Black; printed in the selected gold tone during production).

Silber. If you are using silver only or a combination of gold and silver, place all silver areas on the layer "Metallic Shade 2" and color all elements on this layer using the swatch "Silver" (spot color with 100% Cyan).

Bronze. If you are using bronze, place all bronze areas on the layer "Metallic Shade 3" and color all elements on this layer using the swatch "Bronze" (spot color with 100% Yellow).

NOTE ON GLITTER TATTOOS

Glitter tattoos are printed without white ink. During glitter printing, a layer containing glitter particles is applied beneath the regular color print. These particles reflect light and create a sparkling effect. You can create your print file using standard full-color graphics. We will automatically apply glitter across the entire design during production. The glitter effect is always applied to the entire tattoo sheet — each individual design will sparkle completely.



CUSTOM BACK PRINT

As temporary tattoos are considered cosmetic products, they must be properly labeled. For this reason, the required information is printed on the back of the carrier paper on all our temporary tattoos. The elements highlighted in orange below must be included in the back print. You are welcome to design these elements using a different font or layout. The remaining free areas on the back can be used for your logo or additional information. A grayscale back print (1C) is automatically included with every tattoo order. For an additional charge, the back print can also be produced in full color.

Important! The following information must be included on the back print:



***Important!** Ingredients vary depending on the tattoo type. For example, gold tattoos contain different ingredients than full-color temporary tattoos. For this reason, please download the appropriate layout template including the back print for the respective tattoo type at <https://www.print-tattoo.com/en/print-data-with-layout-templates/>



PRINT TATTOO CERTIFICATES

You can also use the Print Tattoo seals and certificates on your custom back print or on your own product packaging. What you need to pay attention to when using them is explained below.

DERMATOLOGICALLY TESTED

Print Tattoos have been dermatologically tested. However, this seal may only be used if we are stated as the distributor and/or producer. Please note: Depending on the tattoo type, different seals apply. Therefore, always download the current template from our website and do not use older versions. The icon may be used in German or English, depending on the area of application.




VEGAN INGREDIENTS
